Athletes'	Rules of	Conduct	(initial)	١

It is expected that all athletes adhere to certain minimum standards of behavior and scholarship as established by the Blackfoot School Board, MVMS Administration, and the Coach. Parent and Student signature on this form indicates that Parent and Student understand the Rules of Conduct and will abide by them.

- The Student Athlete must have received a 2.0 GPA from previous grading period and maintain a 2.0 GPA for the current grading period. Eligibility also includes the following Upper Snake River Valley Conference Rule:
 - a. To be academically eligible for athletics, a student must be enrolled full-time in his/her school and have received passing grades and earned credits in the required number of courses during the previous reporting period.

 Equivalency is determined by the following criteria:
 - i. 4 classes available.....must pass at least 3
 - ii. 5 classes available.....must pass at least 4
 - iii. 6 classes available.....must pass at least 5
 - iv. 7 classes available.....must pass at least 5
 - v. 8 classes available.....must pass at least 6
- The Student Athlete is not eligible to participate in an organized event or competition of the same sport after tryouts for the school team (example: Jazz, Club, church ball team, etc.). The following USRVC rule applies:
 - a. USRVC does not allow dual participation during any athletic season. Dual participation is defined as practice and/or competition with any group outside the school that involves scoring, timing, officiating. Athletic season is defined as the date of the first opportunity to practice through the end tournament date.

USRVC feels that dual participation allows an unfair advantage for those students who are allowed to participate with an outside group. This would be unfair to our own league members who follow these guidelines. Students who violate this rule will be ineligible for the next regularly scheduled contest plus an additional regularly scheduled contest per infraction. Students who violate this rule a 2nd time will be ineligible the remainder of the student's USRVC athletic tenure. (Contest is defined as but not limited to game, date, or event)

- 3. The Student Athlete will conduct him/herself in an orderly manner at all times in such a way as to bring credit to my team, school, and family.
- 4. The Student Athlete will be personally responsible for all athletic equipment and/or uniforms checked out to them and will return items in good condition or will pay for lost or damaged equipment and/or uniforms.
- 5. The Student Athlete will report all injuries to the Coach immediately.
- 6. The Student Athlete will adhere to the District Athletic Discipline Code.

- 7. The Student Athlete will attend scheduled workouts on time, and notify the Coach beforehand if they need to miss due to illness or emergency.
- 8. The Student Athlete will not be allowed to participate in practices, events, or competitions if the Student Athlete misses any school on the day of practice, event, or competition. Pre-excused doctor or dentist appointments are allowed with a signed doctor note brought to the front office that day.
- 9. The Student Athlete MUST ride the appointed school bus to any athletic event when participating with the school team. Student Athlete may ride home with a parent only when a parent has signed the Student Athlete out with the Coach at the end of any event.

Required Fees and Forms: ((initial)	
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The following items MUST be turned in prior to first day of tryouts:

- 1. **Athletic Physical**: Incoming 7th grade student must have a new physical after May 1 of the previous school year. Physicals are good for 2 years except for incoming 7th grade students and students going into the 9th grade.
- 2. **Sports Questionnaire**: This form must be signed by parent and student athlete. One form per year is sufficient for all sports.

The following items are due before the first scheduled game or the student will not participate with the team, this includes riding the bus and watching the game:

- 3. Student Activity Card: \$12.00 required of all students participating in extracurricular activities.
- 4. **Transportation Fee: \$40.00 due before the first scheduled game.** Please see MVMS financial secretary if you need to make arrangements for payment. A new transportation fee must be paid for each sport a student participates in.

Notice of Risk for Student Athletes	_ (initial)
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We, the undersigned, understand the dangers of practicing, playing, and participating in sports. We also recognize the importance of following instructions given by the coach(es) regarding playing techniques, training, and/or obeying team rules.
